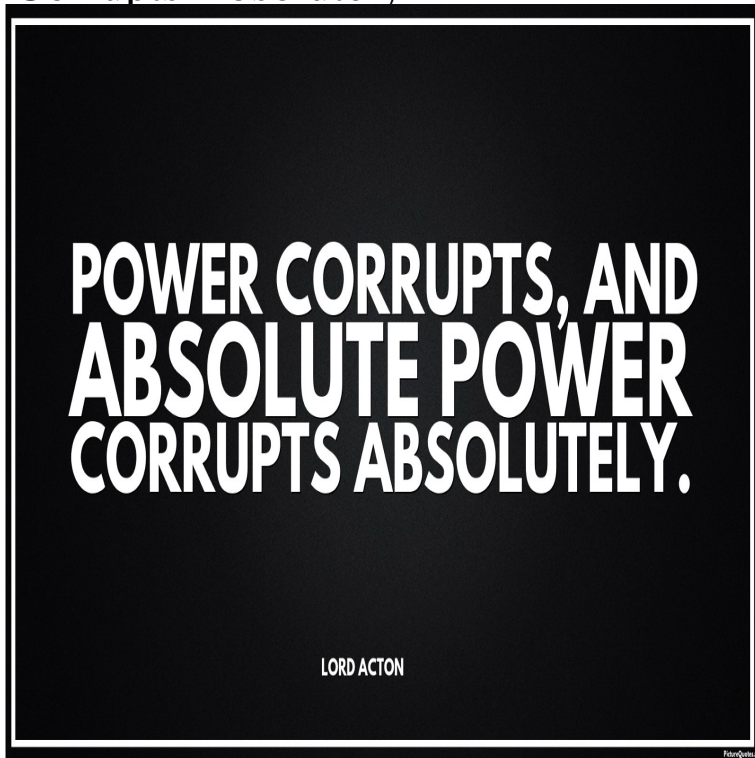


Corrupts Absolutely
